**WHO SHOULD ATTEND:** If you are planning to do farm work, and it is for someone other than a *parent* or *guardian*, and you are 14 or 15 years of age, you must take a tractor safety course following the U.S. Department of Labor requirements before you can be employed at certain hazardous farm tasks. This includes operating a tractor over 20 horsepower.
