- Possess a broad interest in horticulture.
- Support the objectives of the *Master Gardener Program* and the Extension programs of Harper County Extension.
- Be able to read and comprehend an extensive notebook of support materials to be used for future reference.
- Complete the basic *Master Gardener Training Course*.
- Complete 40 hours of volunteer work with Advisory Board-approved projects by the following basic course completion.

Note: In succeeding years, continuation as a *Master Gardener* in good standing requires completion of 10 hours of Advanced Master Gardener training, and a minimum of 20 volunteer hours annually.
